2015 Birth Statistics

There were 1,086 births, 599 males and 599 females. Of all births, 1,034 were at UH Geauga Medical Center, 139 were at the Middlefield Care Center, and there were 13 births at private homes in Geauga County.

2015 Death Statistics

There were 859 deaths recorded in Geauga County for 2015. The Medical Director reviewed the death certificates and supplemental medical certifications and compiled the following leading causes of death. There were 5 child fatalities (<18 years old) in Geauga County in 2015, all of which were the result of extreme prematurity and congenital defects.
